Surviving band members Colin Blunstone and Rod Argent officially reunited in 2004 reinventing the classic Zombies sound with Steve Rodford, Tom Toomey and recently welcoming brand-new member Soren Køch. Absent from the U.S. for 50 years, they completely shocked the nation with what Rolling Stone called an “absolutely triumphant” comeback concert based on their newest album *Still Got That Hunger* (2015). Featuring the fluttery guitar classics and all new songs with Blunstone’s feathery vocals, the group clearly demonstrated their one-of-a-kind sound remained sharp.
